



Core180, LLC Launches after Divesting DATS Contract to Harris CapRock

Core180, LLC To Focus on Delivering Global Networking, Systems Integration and Cloud-based Solutions

FAIRFAX, Va., May 10, 2011 - Core180, a global systems integrator and project management firm with deep experience creating and managing sophisticated telecom and IT network solutions for U.S. government agencies, has announced that it has sold its DISN Access Transport Service (DATS) business, including its DATS-related operating assets, to Harris Corporation and reorganized into Core180, LLC. Terms of the transaction were not disclosed.

The Core180 DATS operation will become part of Harris CapRock Communications. Additionally, Core180 divested its commercial business to Core180 Direct, LLC.

“The sale of our DATS business allows us to monetize this asset and the new Core180, LLC to rapidly expand its efforts to serve U.S. government market places both here and abroad,” said Richard Murphy, Chief Executive Officer of Core180, LLC. “Our focus going forward will be to help our customers move seamlessly into more advanced, secure global networking and cloud-based solutions, delivering both through managed service platforms.”

Core 180, LLC (formerly the Government Markets Division of Core180, Inc.) currently provides telecommunications services to government installations and operations on three continents. Recently, the company has expanded its domestic on-net footprint to provide private, dedicated managed access services to more than 40 domestic and international military locations.

Core180, LLC has expanded its focus on managed bandwidth services and developing and implementing its COREStream™ (a data transfer acceleration platform) and

CORECloud™ (cloud-based computing, networking and disaster recovery services) solutions that will provide government agencies with end-to-end, secure networking capabilities that are at once scalable and cost effective.
